I'm so glad You came to save us.

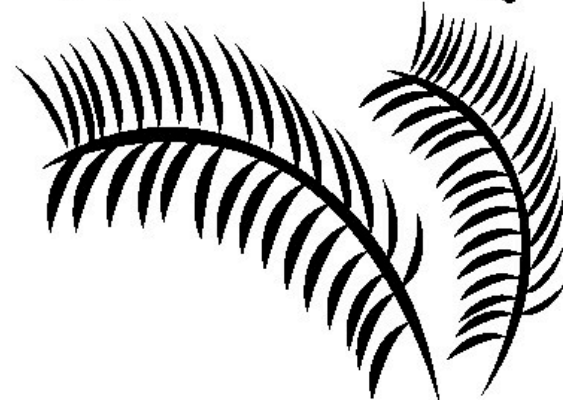
