Introducing: The Holy Spirit

John 1: 32-34

July 10, 2016

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the spirit of God *moved* on the face of the waters. **Genesis 1: 1-2**

The Holy Spirit is like the wind: Although we cannot see him, we see the effects of him. He comes from the Father and from Jesus. **John 14:15-18**

Jesus is describing the work of the Holy Spirit in your life: His purpose is to teach you all things and remind you of everything that Jesus has said. **John 14:26**

Jesus is expecting us to testify about him: We can fulfill his words by knowing what Jesus said and by your own, unique and living testimony. **John 15:26**

The Holy Spirit convicts the world of sin, righteousness and judgment: The world is not convicted of guilt because of being good or bad, but for not believing in Jesus. Because we are incapable of being good enough, we need the righteousness of Jesus. You are the righteousness of God in Christ. God reminds you that the judgment of God ensures that evil is now condemned. **John 16:7**

The Holy Spirit will tell you what is yet to come: He will do this in regard to your life. But remember, some things are best left to God. You can trust the one who will guide you into all truth! **John 16: 12-14**
